



COVID-19 Policies and Procedures:

The health and safety of our CCDC dancers, families, and staff is top priority. To reduce the risk of COVID-19, we kindly ask that you and your dancer(s) follow the updated studio policies and procedures below. Please note: all policies and procedures are subject to change as government and health officials continue to monitor the situation and announce new guidelines.

We thank you for doing your part to keep our studio safe and our dancers healthy!

- **Please stay home if you are sick or have recently been exposed to any illness.** All dancers and their families will be held responsible for making sure that they are healthy before entering the studio. Dancers will not be penalized for missing class due to illness. Please monitor coughing and body temperature regularly.
- **Use hand sanitizer** when you come in the door
- **Wash your hands** after coughing, sneezing, touching your face, and using the bathroom
- **Practice social distancing by using the markings on our floor.** Dancers are expected to remain at least 6 feet apart at all times.
- **Do not touch** the barre or anything else around the classroom unless your teacher gives permission
- **Wear a mask** when you come in, and please keep your mask on during class. We will be mindful of the level of activity during class, cutting back on conditioning, and focusing on smaller repetitions of high intensity activities.
- **Do not enter the studio until the time of your class.** Students and parents should wait outside (in cars if possible) until class begins.
- **No parents will be allowed in the waiting room,** except to make sure your dancer is safely and happily inside the classroom. Students may use the waiting room only to quickly change to and from their dance shoes.
- **Drop-off and pick-up only**
- Arrive to the studio in your dance clothes
- **Leave snacks at home. All water bottles must be clearly marked** so that students do not mix up their own with that of another student.
- Be patient, respectful, and kind. We are all doing our best to keep everyone safe, healthy, and happy!

We will do our part, too, by following these additional procedures:

- **Disinfect and wipe down all touch points, barres, and surfaces before every class**

- **Regularly clean our dance floor with disinfectant**
- Keep extra masks, hand sanitizer, and disinfectant on hand
- **Installation of screen doors in the back of the studio to keep fresh air flowing throughout class**

We understand that this is an unprecedented time, and that the pandemic may cause anxiety and uncertainty for our dancers. Please know that our CCDC teachers will do everything they can to make students feel safe and comfortable and will be sympathetic to any students who are nervous to return to dance. We realize that this is not easy, and that this “new normal” will likely take some adjustment time.

By signing this form, you are acknowledging that you and your dancer(s) have read and fully understand our health and safety policies and procedures. You also understand that any student who does not follow these rules will not be allowed in the classroom. To keep everyone safe, CCDC will uphold a no tolerance policy for failure to respect our rules.
